Global Market Turmoil Over Al Bubble Fears



European and Asian stock markets witnessed a sharp decline this week as fears of an emerging "Al bubble" rattled investors worldwide. Major chipmakers and technology firms saw steep losses, dragging down market indices across regions. The sell-off was triggered by concerns that heavy investments in artificial intelligence and semiconductor sectors may have inflated valuations beyond fundamentals. Analysts warn that if sentiment continues to sour, global tech stocks could face prolonged volatility in the coming weeks.

India imposes an anti-dumping duty on steel imports from Vietnam for five years



India has imposed an anti-dumping duty of \$121.55 per tonne on hot rolled flat steel imports from Vietnam for five years to protect domestic manufacturers from cheap imports. The Finance Ministry notified the decision based on a recommendation from the Directorate General of Trade Remedies (DGTR), which found evidence of dumping. While the move aims to safeguard Indian steel producers and ensure fair trade under WTO rules, user industries have opposed the duty, saying it will raise their costs.

The probe into the deadly car explosion near the Red Fort in Delhi, which killed several people, has been handed over to the National Investigation Agency (NIA), confirming a terror angle. Police continue to detain suspects, including a doctor who is believed to be the bomber.

Delhi-NCR Air Pollution Worsens

Air quality in Delhi-NCR has plunged into the 'Severe' category, with AQI levels crossing 425 in several areas. The government has enforced Stage-3 of the GRAP plan, haiting non-essential construction, restricting older vehicles, and closing stone crushers. Citizens have been urged to stay indoors and work from home as smog blankets the

Reliance to set up 1-GW Al data center in Andhra Pradesh



Reliance Industries will build a 1-GW Al data center in Visakhapatnam, paired with its Jamnagar facility. It will also set up a 6-GWp solar project to power it and a food park in Kurnool. At the CII Summit, Reliance signed 14 MOU's with Andhra Pradesh, adding to its \$25-billion investments in the state.
